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Voice Activated System – Part 1

- I. **John 8:25-28** - *Then they said to Him, Who are You anyway? Jesus replied, [Why do I even speak to you!] I am exactly what I have been telling you from the first. I have much to say about you and to judge and condemn. But He Who sent Me is true (reliable), and I tell the world [only] the things that I have heard from Him. They did not perceive (know, understand) that He was speaking to them about the Father. So Jesus added, When you have lifted up the Son of Man [on the cross], you will realize (know, understand) that I am He [for Whom you look] and that I do nothing of Myself (of My own accord or on My own authority), but I say [exactly] what My Father has taught Me.*
- A. When nothing accomplishes something.
 - B. Jesus repeated what the Father said.
 - C. When the Father speaks two things happen.
 - 1. Something is created.
 - 2. Something is changed.
 - D. Why did the supernatural follow Jesus everywhere He went because it wasn't Jesus talking, it was the Father.
- II. **Isaiah 46:9-10** - *[Earnestly] remember the former things, [which I did] of old; for I am God, and there is no one else; I am God, and there is none like Me, Declaring the end and the result from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My pleasure and purpose.*
- A. We tell it like it is; God tells it like He wants it to be.
 - B. We need to start talking like what we want it to be.
 - C. When you declare you speak something.
 - D. God implemented the voice activated system by His voice.
 - E. The moment God spoke He could no longer create any other way.
 - F. God will never violate His Word.
 - G. The angels says, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty."

- 1. Holy is from a Greek word that means keeper of his word.
 - H. Once God spoke it the universe is still growing at 186,000 miles a second.
 - I. Man is a spirit being that has been given a physical body.
 - J. God made man to have dominion and ruler ship.
 - 1. God gave Adam a voice activated system.
 - K. God created by what He spoke and we create by what we speak.
 - L. What you see was created by what you don't see.
 - 1. Voice activated system moved the unseen to the seen.
 - 2. Calling things that be not as though they were.
 - M. It is better to say nothing than the wrong thing.
- III. **Romans 4:17** - *As it is written, I have made you the father of many nations. [He was appointed our father] in the sight of God in Whom he believed, Who gives life to the dead and speaks of the nonexistent things that [He has foretold and promised] as if they [already] existed.*
- A. It was written in Genesis 17:5.
 - B. When God spoke it Abraham did not have one child.
 - C. God changed Abraham's name because He needed Abraham to call things that be not as though they were.
 - D. As long as Abraham did not doubt no demon could stop it.
 - E. You're going to have to believe God.
 - F. When you speak of things that be not as though they were they will be.
 - G. Your words change your world.
- IV. **Romans 4:18-20** - *[For Abraham, human reason for] hope being gone, hoped in faith that he should become the father of many nations, as he had been promised, So [numberless] shall your descendants be. He did not weaken in faith when he considered the [utter] impotence of his own body, which was as good as dead because he was about a hundred years old, or [when he considered] the barrenness of Sarah's*

[deadened] womb. No unbelief or distrust made him waver (doubtingly question) concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong and was empowered by faith as he gave praise and glory to God.

- A. What comes out of your heart through the words of your mouth determines what will come to pass in your life.
- V. **Matthew 28:18** - *Jesus approached and, breaking the silence, said to them, All authority (all power of rule) in heaven and on earth has been given to Me.*
- A. Jesus had all authority and He gave it to the church.
 - B. We got the authority and the power.
- VI. **Acts 1:8** - *But you shall receive power (ability, efficiency, and might) when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be My witnesses in Jerusalem and all Judea and Samaria and to the ends (the very bounds) of the earth.*
- VII. **Acts 2:1-4** - *AND WHEN the day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all assembled together in one place, When suddenly there came a sound from heaven like the rushing of a violent tempest blast, and it filled the whole house in which they were sitting. And there appeared to them tongues resembling fire, which were separated and distributed and which settled on each one of them. And they were all filled (diffused throughout their souls) with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other (different, foreign) languages (tongues), as the Spirit kept giving them clear and loud expression [in each tongue in appropriate words].*
- A. Cloven tongues, divided tongues, tongues of fire.
 - B. When you get filled with the Holy Ghost you have more power spiritually.
 - 1. It was the power of the tongue.
- VIII. **John 7:38-39** - *He who believes in Me [who cleaves to and trusts in and relies on Me] as the Scripture has said, From his innermost being shall flow [continuously] springs and rivers of living water. But He was speaking here of the Spirit, Whom those who believed (trusted, had faith) in Him were afterward to receive. For the [Holy] Spirit had not yet been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified (raised to honor).*
- A. When the Holy Spirit comes upon you, you have power, the power of the tongue.
 - B. Living water changes dead situations.

IX. **Hebrews 4:12** - *For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective]; it is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the breath of life (soul) and [the immortal] spirit, and of joints and marrow [of the deepest parts of our nature], exposing and sifting and analyzing and judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart.*

- A. The Word of God is the word that God speaks.
- B. When God speaks a word it is full of power.
- C. A two edged sword is sharp on both sides and can cut any way you slice it.

X. **Revelation 1:12-16** - *Then I turned to see [whose was] the voice that was speaking to me, and on turning I saw seven golden lampstands, And in the midst of the lampstands [One] like a Son of Man, clothed with a robe which reached to His feet and with a girdle of gold about His breast. His head and His hair were white like white wool, [as white] as snow, and His eyes [flashed] like a flame of fire. His feet glowed like burnished (bright) bronze as it is refined in a furnace, and His voice was like the sound of many waters. In His right hand He held seven stars, and from His mouth there came forth a sharp two-edged sword, and His face was like the sun shining in full power at midday.*

- A. The Word of God is the sword of the spirit.
- B. You never handle this sword with your hands.
- C. God's two edged sword was meant to be handled with your mouth.
 - 1. It is the power of the tongue.
- D. You have power in your words.
- E. Two edged is from the Greek word distomos.
 - 1. Dis is two; tomos is mouth.
- F. Originally in the Greek it was called a two mouth word.
 - 1. It is the word that God spoke.
 - 2. When God spoke it He was the first mouth and He put power in the Word.
 - 3. When you speak it you are the second mouth and you release the power that God put in the Word.

- G. Your words are one mouth words.
 - H. When you speak God's Word it accomplishes the perfect will of God.
 - I. You are the second mouth to His Word.
 - J. His mouth puts power in the Word; your mouth causes that power to be released from the Word.
- XI. **Matthew 6:31** - *Therefore do not worry and be anxious, saying, What are we going to have to eat? or, What are we going to have to drink? or, What are we going to have to wear?*
- A. The moment you open your mouth you are creating your world.
 - B. God's Kingdom is a worry free kingdom.
 - 1. Worry is not allowed in God's kingdom.
 - C. When you worry you have taken the responsibility for yourself to yourself.
 - D. When you live in the Kingdom of God you are no longer responsible for your needs; God is responsible for your needs.
 - 1. You have Jehovah Jireh who will meet all your needs.
 - E. The moment you speak words of worry you stop God's move in your life.
 - F. You will be held accountable for every idle word.
 - G. Your words will either progress God's plan or regress God's plan.
 - H. There's a connection between thoughts and words.
 - I. What you think is what you will say; what you say will create your world.
- XII. **Matthew 6:32-33** - *For the Gentiles (heathen) wish for and crave and diligently seek all these things, and your heavenly Father knows well that you need them all. But seek (aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness (His way of doing and being right), and then all these things taken together will be given you besides.*
- A. The Kingdom is God's way of doing things.
 - B. God's way of doing things is voice activated system.
 - C. Righteousness is God's way of thinking.

1. Thoughts turn into words.
- D. If the devil can feed you a thought he can get you to use your words against yourself.
 - E. Jesus stripped the devil of all power.
 - F. When you seek God's thoughts you will manifest His words.
- XIII. **Isaiah 55:11** - *So shall My word be that goes forth out of My mouth: it shall not return to Me void [without producing any effect, useless], but it shall accomplish that which I please and purpose, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.*
- A. A second mouth has to be added to the Word for it to accomplish what it was sent for.
- XIV. **Psalms 103:20** - *Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, you His angels, you mighty ones who do His commandments, hearkening to the voice of His word.*
- A. When you give God's Word voice the angels move.
 - B. The angels move at God's Words.
- XV. **Daniel 9:1-3** - *IN THE first year of Darius son of Ahasuerus, of the offspring of the Medes, who was made king over the realm of the Chaldeans--In the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, understood from the books the number of years which, according to the word of the Lord to Jeremiah the prophet, must pass by before the desolations [which had been] pronounced on Jerusalem should end; and it was seventy years. And I set my face to the Lord God to seek Him by prayer and supplications, with fasting and sackcloth and ashes.*
- A. Daniel found a Jeremiah scroll.
 - B. Daniel prayed what he read in the scrolls of Jeremiah which was the Word of God.
- XVI. **Daniel 10:12** - *Then he said to me, Fear not, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your mind and heart to understand and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard, and I have come as a consequence of [and in response to] your words.*
- A. Daniel spoke God's word.
 - B. The angels hearken to the voice of God's Word.
 - C. When you start talking like it were, it will be.

- D. Your words either match your faith or cancel it.
- E. You can't speak sickness and poverty and expect health and wealth.
- F. We arrange things when we speak.
- G. I must call His Words.
 - 1. You better do some calling.

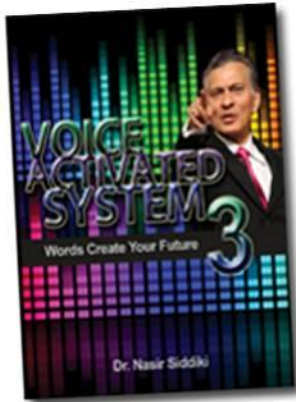
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- A. Repetition.

XIX. **Hebrews 3:1** - *SO THEN, brethren, consecrated and set apart for God, who share in the heavenly calling, [thoughtfully and attentively] consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest Whom we confessed [as ours when we embraced the Christian faith].*

- A. Jesus is the High Priest of our confession.
- B. Confession is from the Greek word homologia which means covenant acknowledgement.
- C. Acknowledge your covenant and He will manifest it.
- D. Jesus is the High Priest of your words.
- E. We arrange things when we speak.
- F. Neurologists have proven that the speech center of the brain drives and controls all the systems of the body.
 - 1. Your body has to cooperate with what you say.



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
